#### Helpful Hints for Novice Rallyists By Ted Ohland

#### Don't Get Lost!

In the first place, remember that being on time on the wrong road does not help you win a rally. It makes sense to place your first priority on finding your way through the route. Follow instructions explicitly. Don't try to out-guess the rallymaster. Do no more or less than the instructions require and assume nothing you don't have to assume. Rallying is a sport in which ability to follow instructions (or lack of such ability) separates winners from losers. Do each instruction at the place described, not some place that looks temptingly like the place described; and if the mileage is given, do nothing at any other place except notice that the mileage is wrong. At every instruction including mileage, Mileage MUST be right.

#### Converting Your Mileage to Agree with Official Mileage

Almost certainly, your odometer will not read out mileages identical with those measured by the rallymaster's car (the 'official' mileage). The key to knowing where you are along the rally route lies in being able to convert your odometer reading into official miles. In the second section of the rally (or the first, if there is no tire warm-up section), you should establish the relationship between your odometer and the official odometer used to measure the route. You should find a linear relationship (unless one of your tires has a slow leak!) Mathematically, you can discover a factor by which to multiply your odometer mileage and determine the official mileage by the following method:

Take careful measurements in the odometer calibration section (up to the end of the Free Zone) and compare them with the official mileages. By dividing official mileage into your mileage, at several references, you should be able to notice a consistent ratio, which, with a little multiplication will convert official miles to your miles and enable you to make predictions and perform other notable feats of navigation. Example: If at official mileage 10.000 your odometer reads 10.500, your factor is 10.500 / 10.000 = 1.050, which means that at official mileage 20.000 your odometer will read 20.000 1.050, which is 21.000 miles, etc.

If at official mileage 10.000 your odometer had read 9.500 miles, you would again divide the official mileage into your mileage to find your odometer factor: 9.500 / 10.000 = 0.9500, which means that at official mileage 20.000 your odometer will read 20.000 0.950, which is 19.000 miles, etc.

Those who hope to luck in at the trophy presentation ceremonies without going through the pain are referred to the first paragraph above. Many an award has been won by a team that barely navigated mathematically, if at all. This is usually accomplished by the driver's good sense of speed (seat of the pants time sense) and the navigator's ability to give an accurate time check every now and then. What wins trophies is being somewhere near on time on the right road. Not getting lost works, especially if most of the competition has been sucked down the wrong road by anxiety, carelessness or any of a hundred other reasons.

Most of all, relax and have fun. Enjoy the scenery. Rallymasters have a knack of finding pretty places that most people haven't had the ambition to discover. The route will usually avoid main highways and built-up areas, concentrating on roads that offer something other than traffic to capture your attention. If you want to stay on course though, you'll have to notice what the rally master noticed about that misspelled road sign, or the way that street with the strange name turned right instead of continuing straight ahead.

Go get 'em!



### The 2005 Northern New Jersey Region Road Racing Championship for the Victoria Cup

**Eligibility:** In order for a Competitor to be eligible to earn points and compete for the Championship he/she shall be a member of NNJR, enter and compete in all three NNJR Regional Races in 2005 [Double Regional at Pocono on 5/14-15 and the Regional at Lime Rock on 8/5-6]. A driver shall be classified as a starter or have qualified in each of the three races to be considered eligible for the championship. Failure to be a starter or to qualify for each race will render a competitor ineligible for the Championship. All employees, owners, agents of Victoria Motorsports are ineligible for points towards the Championship. NNJR will tally all points and it is not necessary for a competitor to register or forward results sheets. All drivers will be considered for the Championship by virtue of entering the first race at Pocono on 5/15/2005. The Champion and other prize winners will be the Drivers who satisfy the aforementioned criteria, accumulates the most points and attends the NNJR Annual Dinner and Awards Banquet. In the event the Drivers with the highest accumulated points meeting the aforementioned eligibility criteria does not attend the Banquet then the championship trophy and prize money will be awarded to the Drivers in attendance with the most accumulated points meeting the eligibility criteria.

**Points:** Each competitor that finishes pursuant to the Official final results will be awarded points as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup> place	30 points	10 <sup>th</sup> place	16 points	18 <sup>th</sup> place	8 points
2 <sup>nd</sup> place	27 points	11 <sup>th</sup> place	15 points	19 <sup>th</sup> place	7 points
3 <sup>rd</sup> place	25 points	12 <sup>th</sup> place	14 points	20 <sup>th</sup> place	6 points
4 <sup>th</sup> place	23 points	13 <sup>th</sup> place	13 points	21 <sup>st</sup> place	5 points
5 <sup>th</sup> place	21 points	14 <sup>th</sup> place	12 points	22 <sup>nd</sup> place	4 points
6 <sup>th</sup> place	20 points	15 <sup>th</sup> place	11 points	23 <sup>rd</sup> place	3 points

In addition, one additional point will be awarded for each car a competitor finishes ahead of, including cars that are classified as DNF"s, (i.e. if a competitor finishes 3<sup>rd</sup> in class and there were 9 cars in his/her class the driver will receive 31 total points for that race regardless of whether all 9 cars are eligible to compete for the Championship).

In the event of a tie the winners shall be decided based upon the number of first place finishes in class, then if necessary, the number of second place finishes in class, etc.

**Judges:** The NNJR Club Racing Committee shall act as the judge for this Championship and shall decide all matters including ties and disputes in their sole discretion.

1<sup>st</sup> place prize — Victoria Cup Trophy and \$200.00 2<sup>nd</sup> place prize — \$100.00 3<sup>rd</sup> place prize — \$50.00




