Not too long ago, someone asked me what kind of car I drove. I replied that I drove a “sports car”, a Chrysler Crossfire. 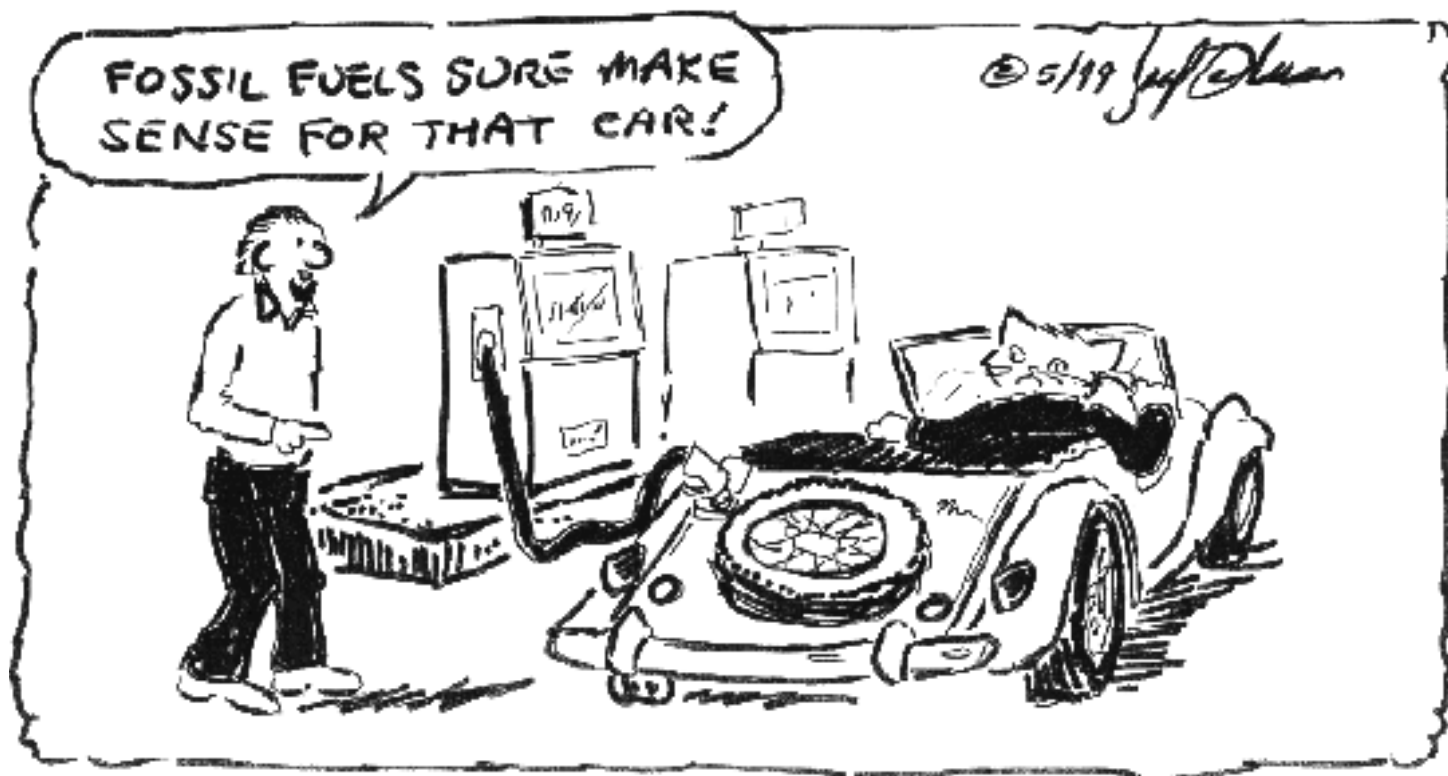
