Before we can talk about where we want to go in 2012 we need to take a quick look back at 2011. Here is a brief State of the Club Report. Some of last year's events were profitable and some were not. The Drivers School in March lost money as expected as did the Pocono event but we showed a profit at the Lime Rock event where we partnered with the Mo-Hud region (actually good considering this was a one day regional). We were even at the Lightning event and ahead at Thunderbolt in August. At the "JERK" we were down but better than the previous years as we continue to try and make this a great season ending event. Our Solo division was down in 2011 due to increased cost for the new venue, The Meadowlands, the National Solo and some bad weather during the season. The Rally program continued on and was only down slightly from 2010.

Looking at 2012, we will continue to co-sanction events together with the South Jersey Region as the Jersey Racing Board (JRB). We will also partner with Mo-Hud again at the Lime Rock event. These partnerships have worked out well for all of us and we will continue to build on these as we move forward.

John is 94 years young and was recently beset with some major medical problems. Now largely recovered from these medical issues, John is living in the Noble Horizons retirement community in Salisbury Connecticut about six miles from his home on Salmon Kill Road in Lime Rock. I understand he splits his time between Noble Horizons and his Lime Rock home, probably driving back and forth in his Fitch Phoenix prototype.

Dave Panas bought some aftermarket floor mats for his Mini a while back and he is quite enthusiastic about the manufacturer of the mats. Seems a fellow named Dave MacNeil is the founder & CEO of a company called **WeatherTech**. The company manufactures a variety of aftermarket automotive products and is totally behind the "Made in America" concept. Not only are all of WeatherTech's products manufactured using American labor right here in the states, all their manufacturing machinery is also made in America and the raw materials from which the products are made all originate here. It sure doesn't sound like a Walmart type operation to me.

On December 9th some 548 needy kids from nineteen schools nearby to **New Jersey Motorsports Park** spent the day enjoying themselves as guests of the track. They weren't there to spectate at the races. Rather each of these kids was invited to select a new coat, some gloves, a hat, a scarf and other items to ward off winter's cold. They enjoyed a hot, healthy lunch and a visit with Santa Claus. All this was provided through the "**Coats For Kids**" holiday program hosted by the **NJMP Green Flag Children's Charities**.

Our October Regional event, "**The JERK**" had the Coats for Kids campaign as its dedicated charity. Many of the race teams donated new coats or money toward the effort, and all the money collected on the lunchtime track drive-arounds went toward the purchase of more coats and other warm items for the program.

The race just mentioned in the previous paragraph – "The JERK" — was the last SCCA race event on the 2011 NorthEast Division calendar. For the second year in a row the weather for our late October race date was really nice. We had a large turnout of competitors – I believe the car count was 157 — wanting to get in one last event before putting their race cars up on blocks and tearing apart the motors to prepare for the 2012 season. Folks got three races over the two day weekend and counting all the races – qualifying and feature – there were seven new lap records set. I really think everyone went home happy. It was a great way to end the 2011 race season.

Another press release from **NJMP** announced that a south Jersey tradition was being moved to the Lightning track at NJMP for the holiday season. A family named Meischke has had a 40-year tradition at Christmastime of decorating their home with over 250,000 lights. The display was known as "**The Meischke Christmas Wonderland of Lights**." When the family patriarch passed away, the display which had attracted tens of thousands of spectators each holiday season, was threatened. NJMP stepped in to partner with the Meischke family and brought the display to the karting track for the holidays. Continuing a tradition which had begun with the Meischke family, a nominal charge was made for families to tour the lights display with the proceeds benefiting the "**Make-A-Wish**" foundation.

Knowing that **Bill Von Suskil**, **Grid Chief for South Jersey Region** had visited the "Christmas Wonderland of Lights" in early December, I asked him for a report. **Bill**, his wife **Diane**, daughter **Dana** and her husband **Matt**, along with grandkids, **Jonathan** (4) & **Carly** (2) all thought it was great! He says there was a raging bonfire just outside the gate and kids were enjoying themselves roasting marshmallows and drinking hot chocolate as they arrived.

Bill's report continues: "As we walked onto the Karting track, we entered into a tunnel of Christmas lights. Waiting at the end was a display of Snoopy and his friends. Throughout the walk of lights there were a number of lighted displays of cut-out characters to add to the children's joy and amazement. As we completed our walk through the maze of white and colored Christmas lights and displays, to our delight was Santa's workshop with animated elves working feverously on this year's deliveries. Upon exiting the

karting track past the winners' podium we stopped for photos. We noticed that the big man himself was in the karting building receiving guests of all ages with their latest lists for the night of all nights. After visiting Jolly Olde Saint Nick we had to get more pictures with the snowman ice sculpture on the way to the car. As we drove off over the bridge with the lights of the Meischke Wonderland of Lights dimming out of sight, I heard my grandson say, "Pop Pop can we go back?" It was truly a very enjoyable night for the entire family." Sounds like it's worth a drive down to Millville next year to see it in person!



I have previously mentioned how much Nancy & I enjoy the theatrical productions put on each summer at the **TriArts Sharon Playhouse** – the red barn theater almost everyone heading to Lime Rock from New Jersey has to pass on the edge of Sharon,

Connecticut as they drive to the track. The theater has announced the three productions for 2012 season: "Altar Boys" — "The Best Little Whorehouse in Texas" & "The Sound of Music" My guess is that 2012 will once again be a stellar season at TriArts.

In the last Pole Cat I commented that, while Nancy and I felt the new **Flight 93 Memorial** was beautiful and was a wonderful expression of remembrance to the forty heroes, at the same time we missed seeing all the simpler tributes which average Americans had been leaving behind at the former **Temporary Memorial**. In a recent exchange of notes which I had with **Jeff Reinbold** the new National Park Service Manager for the Flight 93 Memorial, Jeff wrote, "You probably already know this, but we are currently designing the exhibit area in the visitor center and are including space for items from the Temporary Memorial (as well as others collected at the Wall of Names) to be displayed in a rotating exhibit." This exhibit area should be open in 2013 and Nancy & I look forward to again seeing some of the remembrances which average folks felt a need to leave – almost as a way of saying "Thank you for your sacrifice." We encourage you to try to get to see it also – but please don't allow the future completion date for this exhibit in the visitor center cause you to cancel any earlier opportunity you may have to visit and see the rest of the new memorial.




