Rallye:

The Oct. 10th rallye event was profitable. Rallye program is profitable for 2021

The NJ Monte rallye had 15 cars and was a very successful event.

On Dec. 5th the Region is holding the Teddy Bear Rallye

Treasurer's Report:

We have money to cover our expenses.

The Oct. 10th national rallye finance report is outstanding. Income from these events went to SJR. They will pay us a portion of the proceeds since we ran them together, but used their registration account.

Race:

We have learned of a conflict with the 2022 Memorial Day Majors event the Region was planning. There is a Watkins Glen Super Tour the following weekend. Peter Schneider will address this conflict at the divisional level to ask if this can be changed so that it is not in conflict with our event. The event at Watkins Glen counts toward qualification for the Run Offs. Races counting for qualification for the Run Offs need to be complete no less than 3 weeks before the Run Offs. This might impact our ability to have a Pocono event in 2022.

Rally-x:

The team is getting in contact with Ort Farm in Long Valley, NJ to see if we might be able to run an event there. They currently run monster trucks there in a field for visitors to ride in. A second field is used strictly for parking.

More to come on this after contact is made.

Solo:

Perry Aidelbaum working on having year-end trophies made. As in the past, he asked the trophy winners if they want a trophy or let us put the funds towards 2022. Usually, about 30% will take a trophy. This helps us put some of the money back into the program. In exchange, I will give anyone not taking a trophy a new cone to bring home and decorate to be used on the course in 2022.

Mark Labbancz and Perry Aidelbaum will discuss if we have a 2021 Solo Worker of the Year and report back to the Board.

No update on the 2022 schedule yet, other than the May 20-22, 2022 Pro Solo.

We will need to order new cones before the season starts.

Our last event was a success. We had 118 people, and the event was profitable. We started doing a no work option where a few people can decide to pay extra and not work.

Board Activities:

We will address worker awards at the December 2021 meeting.

We have heard no follow-up after our response to the photo copyright complaint.

Peter Schneider is looking for a 2022 budget from each specialty, by Jan. 1, 2022.

Membership:

Old Business:
