Jason Treasurer's Report

- 990 Corporation Tax Form due Wednesday
- Tax Year 2023 Gains and Losses
 - Administration
 - We got less membership dues in 2023 compared to 2022
 - \$2,151 loss (-17% margin)
 - Club Racing
 - \$18,242 loss (-21% margin)
 - Rally
 - \$576 profit
 - o Solo
 - (Including \$7000 journal entry from solo to club racing) \$4400 loss
 - Overall for 2023 our region has a \$21,244 loss (-14% margin)
 - Operating income is at \$27,657 (doesn't include the check from the last event at MetLife, which would put us to about \$21,000)
 - More expenses can be deducted including:
 - Storage
 - Quickbooks
 - Reserve is at \$3211
 - Jason may add \$5000 to make sure that we're above

\$8k and avoid any bank fees for not having enough money in the account

- Solo was profitable last year, but administration fees and the Pocono event really set us back
- One big expense paid in May was insurance for all of the vehicles, so we're covered for the year. Jason is just waiting on insurance cards.
 - South Jersey agreed to pay registration and insurance for Vanna White (they'll owe us around \$1500)
 - They may also buy the van from us outright

Perry Solo Report Mark Update on So

Update on Solo events held and future events

- Made about \$1800 with the ProSolo
- Mark squeezed out a trophy spot from Perry by .084 seconds!
- Had an event with around 105 cars last Saturday
 - Estimated \$700 profit
- The Marotta event had to be postponed to the fall, and we won't have a date until the MetLife football schedule is released.
 - This event is one of the most profitable events of the year (last year we made \$2600 profit)

Financial update

- Monthly price of storing the solo truck going up significantly.
 - (25ft long, 7ft wide, 11ft 3in tall, small chassis class C motorhome)
 - Stable Energies and ID Signs were both mentioned as potential new storage locations
 - SJR stores their truck on farmland when not in use
 - Linda mentioned that we could all try to pool efforts to find a new facility to store the truck
